

DONATION GUIDELINES

We all have items in our closet that don't fit our body or our lifestyle! Clean out your closet and be a blessing to others! Be *intentional* when you donate – if it's not something you'd feel comfortable giving to your mom, your sister, or your best friend, it's probably “*too loved*”!

We want our merchandise to be *treasures* because our ladies are *treasures*!

- Current or classic styling in sizes 0 through 5X
- Please no stains, flaws, rips, or odors.
- Current season - (exceptions: moving or death in the family)
- Notable brand names such as CHICOs, Ann Taylor, Coldwater Creek, Talbots, etc. (Thanks – but we don't take hangers!)
- We accept sleepwear, suits, dresses, blouses, skirts, casual wear, sportswear, pants, jeans, coats, After-Five, maternity, shoes, purses, hats, scarves, and jewelry.
- No appointment necessary – stop in during regular store hours (see below).
- We suggest that you jot down your inventory list before donating and staple it to our duplicated tax receipt – yellow copy for you and white copy for us. According to IRS regulations, we *cannot* assign a value; check suggested values online or use our price list as a reference and go a little up nor down dependent on age, condition and style.



IRS says there are no fixed formulas or methods for determining the fair market value of donated clothing. Factors to consider include the age of the clothing, how worn it is, whether it's in or out of style and how readily it can be used. Further, the fair market value is the price the clothing would get in the present day and in its current condition; it's not the price you paid for the clothing when it was new. Finally, the clothing must be in "good used condition or better," or you cannot take any deduction for it.

One suggestion the IRS makes is to look for similar items at used clothing stores, thrift stores and consignment shops. The prices paid by buyers there are a good indicator of the value of the clothing, and you can use them if the IRS questions your deduction.
